#### ESTATE

**Name:** Fortified Hamlet in the village of Montemassi.

**Location:** The property is situated in the Monteregio DOC appellation on Mediterranean coast of Tuscany. There are over 1,060 acres on the approximately 385 acres dedicated to vineyards.

**Elevation:** 1,148 - 1,181 ft. above sea level.

**Soil:** A mixture of rich clay, minerals and sand.

**Climate:** Maritime, characterized by warm days and cool nights. Temperatures range from 39°- 41°F in the winter and remain at around 86°F in the summer.

**Training System:** Spurred Cordon and Guyot.

**Vine Density:** 5,000 vines per hectare.

**Varietals:** Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Vermentino, Merlot, Syrah, Petit Verdot, Viogner.

#### POINTS OF INTEREST

- Maremma, Tuscany is considered the “California of Italy” and the terroir is home to the world-renowned Super Tuscan wines.
- At the heart of the estate lies a monument in commemoration of the 43 miners that perished in 1954 during one of the worst mining accident in Italian history.
- In the spirit of giving back to the community, the Zonin family established a successful canine rescue shelter at the estate.



#### HISTORICAL NOTES

Rocca di Montemassi is located in Maremma on the Mediterranean coast of Tuscany, contrasted by rolling hills and swampland. Maremma, one of the youngest wine producing areas in Italy, has been coveted over the centuries for its abundance in metals and natural resources. In 1999, the Zonin family acquired the property and the estate has become a symbol for biodiversity and sustainability in the region. In the spring of 2012, Maremma Toscana was granted DOC status.
