## VINIFICATION

Fermentation takes place in horizontal stainless steel tanks at the controlled temperature of between 61°-64°F. The wine then matures for 12 months in Allier oak barriques in the Berengario cellar at the Zonin's cellar in Gambellara, and ages for a further period in bottle before being released.

## COLOR

Ruby red with garnet undertones.

## BOUQUET

Full and complex with scents of red berries and pines fused with sweet vanilla tones.

## PALATE

Soft and dry with pleasant dark fruit, smooth tannins and an elegant persistent finish.

## FOOD PAIRINGS

Excellent with red meat dishes (especially roasts), game or mature cheeses.
