VINIFICATION

The 200 acres of Sangiovese grapes used for this wine are machine harvested and fermented using the traditional method, in the presence of the skins. Malolactic fermentation occurs in steel tanks and the wine is aged in 3,400 liter Slavonian oak casks for 12 months. This is followed by 3 months of aging in the bottle. The average age of the vines is around 20 years, and since 1999, 25 acres have been replanted per year.

COLOR

Light ruby-red color with orange hues.

BOUQUET

Strawberry and red berries with notes of sage, spice cake and subtle earth.

PALATE

Vibrant and medium bodied revealing lively cherry and exotic spice that lead to polished tannins and a delicate finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Goes well with almost all types of meats and fish that are grilled, barbecued, marinated, roasted and stuffed.
